For the first time in almost 50 years, the NFIP's premium rating structure has been updated. Risk Rating 2.0 incorporates modern insurance industry technologies to price flood insurance for each home individually rather than by flood zone. It will provide more accurate rates as property-specific characteristics, such as a building's unique elevation, distance to water and cost to rebuild will be factored in, as well as other flood risk factors. While most policyholders will not see significant rate increases immediately, some will see increases when rates for existing policies go into effect on April 1st which may become significant year over year. 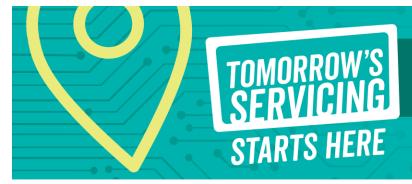
